# What are the learning objectives?

Since you now know how to talk about your job, your family, your weekly plans, your likes and desires; we plan on equipping you with a variety of new verbs and vocabularies, including weather, looks and appearances, holidays,

shopping and traveling among others. At the end of this ten-class course, you will be able to:

- Converse about a range of interesting topics such as weather, shopping, clothes, colors,family and work, using new themed vocabularies.
- . Use a variety of verbs related to the mentioned themes in present simple, present continuous, and future tenses.

- Use a variety of new adjectives and characteristics.

#### Why Levantine?

Learning a language is always about engaging with the community and getting a true sense of what that language represents to locals, and how they interact on a daily basis. That's why we chose for our course the Levantine dialect, one of the six main varieties of colloquial Arabic spoken across the Arab world, as it is the main vernacular spoken in Syria, Lebanon, Palestine and Jordan. Compared to the Modern Standard Arabic (MSA), used more formally, Levantine dialect is easier to pronounce and understand, widely spoken, and more accessible, being adopted by most of the art and cultural movements in the Arab world.

#### Information about the course

By booking this language course, you are choosing a 10-week group language course, which will take place digitally once a week. The classes start on Thursday, February 6th, from 6:30 - 8:00 pm. Then there are 9 more sessions, every Thursday at the same time.

The course officially ends on April 4th with a small final test. If you pass the test and participate regularly, you will receive a certificate of participation from us.

Participation in the course takes place via Zoom. You will receive the dial-in data after booking as part of a detailed preparatory email.
