Why Levantine?

Learning a language is always about engaging with the community and getting a true sense of what that language represents to locals, and how they interact on a daily basis. That's why we chose for our course the Levantine dialect, one of the six main varieties of colloquial Arabic spoken across the Arab world, as it is the main vernacular spoken in Syria, Lebanon, Palestine and Jordan. Compared to the Modern Standard Arabic (MSA), used more formally, Levantine dialect is easier to pronounce and understand, widely spoken, and more accessible, being adopted by most of the art and cultural movements in the Arab world

What should you expect?

In this course, you'll also learn how to describe people and actions more clearly using active participles (إسم الفاحل), and how to talk about changes over time using verbs like الله على and by. With the support of a custom-designed Arabic language booklet by your teacher Lilas, you'll strengthen your ability to express yourself through guided dialogues, engaging exercises, and short video clips from the Syrian drama series Undocumented. As always, learning will stay fun and practical with games, visuals, role plays, and in-class conversations that bring the language to life.

What are the learning objectives?

This course is designed to help you carry out more fluent and expressive conversations in everyday and cultural settings. You'll build on your existing knowledge while learning to connect vocabulary, grammar, and context more confidently and naturally.

Content Right Column:

By the end of this ten-class course, you will be able to:

- Talk about morning visits (ṣubḥiyyeh) and other common social gatherings.
- Use active participles (إسم الفاعل) to describe people and their actions.
- Compare the past and present using صار and صار in full sentences.
- Discuss technology at work and how it has changed daily life.
- Express your thoughts and questions about customs and traditions in the Middle East.
- Use a wider range of vocabulary to describe situations, preferences, and social norms.
- Develop Listening and Narration Skills: Watch and analyze a short episode (3-5 minutes) from the Syrian sociopolitical drama Undocumented in each session, using it to enhance listening comprehension, narrative vocabulary, and reporting skills.

Information about the course

By booking this language course, you are choosing a 10-week group language course. Starting on Monday, May 12th 2025, you will receive a session of 2 Study hours (1,5h). This would be followed by 9 more sessions, every Monday at the same time. The course will officially end on July 14th 2025 with a small final test. If you pass the test and participate regularly, you will receive a certificate of participation from us.

Participation in the course takes place via Zoom. You will receive the dial-in data after booking as part of a detailed preparatory email.
